



Junior Players Code of Conduct

These club expects that all junior players will follow these rules;

- Follow the rules and be kind and friendly to the other people who are playing.
- Listen to the coaches and try your best all the time
- Listen to umpires. Show respect and never argue with them. The umpire's decision is final
- Always wear a gum shield and shin pads to protect yourself.
- Always look after your team mates and tell an adult if someone is hurt or upset.
- Never bully or tease others. Bullies are not welcome at Alton Hockey Club.
- Never swear or use inappropriate language or gestures.
- Be a good winner and a good loser. This means always doing 3 cheers to the other team and saying "well done" even if you're upset at losing
- Set a good example for younger players
- Never participate when under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Arrive on time. Wear suitable clothes for training and club kit for matches and tournaments.
- Talk to your coach or the welfare officer straight away if something is wrong or someone is upsetting you or hurting you
- Use the club's social media responsibly. Remember that adult members, parents and the public can see what you post. The rules above also apply to content you post online.
